SUBJECT:	Expression of Interest – Surf Sports RWC Coordinator & IRB Coordinator for Season 2025/26
OVERVIEW:	Surf Life Saving Sydney is seeking Expressions of Interest for a Surf Sports RWC Coordinator and IRB Coordinator to join the Surf Life Saving Sydney Surf Sports Committee for the 2026/2027 season.

Surf Life Saving Sydney is seeking Expressions of Interest for two valuable roles to join the Surf Life Saving Sydney Surf Sports Committee for the 2026/2027 season.

Role 1: RWC Coordinator

The Surf Sports RWC Coordinator will work closely with the Surf Sports Committee and the Sydney Branch Support Operations Team to coordinate RWC support for Surf Life Saving Sydney surf sports events throughout the season.

Responsibilities include:

- Working with the Surf Sports Committee and Support Operations Team to identify RWC requirements for Surf Life Saving Sydney surf sports events.
- Coordinating and maintaining a roster of suitably qualified RWC Operators for Surf Life Saving Sydney events.
- Ensuring adequate RWC coverage is arranged in advance of each event.
- Liaising with event organisers, Surf Sports Safety & Logistics, and Support Operations regarding event requirements.
- Communicating with rostered RWC Operators prior to events and confirming availability.
- Assisting with the coordination of RWC resources to support the safe and effective delivery of Surf Life Saving Sydney Championships and special events.

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Role 2: IRB Coordinator

The IRB Coordinator will support the planning and delivery of Surf Life Saving Sydney Championships and special events by coordinating IRB personnel and club rosters.

Responsibilities include:

- Working with the Surf Life Saving Sydney Championship Committee to identify IRB personnel requirements for each championship or event and, in consultation with the Surf Sports Committee, developing suitable Club IRB rosters to meet those requirements.
- Ensuring rostered clubs are available and able to fulfil their IRB requirements on the day of each event.
- Liaising with the Surf Sports Committee regarding any roster changes or replacements required before or during an event.
- Working with the Surf Sports Safety Manager and Logistics Manager at events to ensure all IRB requirements are met and appropriate IRB coverage is maintained.
- Supporting the safe and effective delivery of Surf Life Saving Sydney Championships and Special Events conducted by the Surf Sports Committee.
